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Eligibility:

- Applicant must be currently enrolled, as a full-time (12 hours undergraduate or 9 hours graduate) college or university student in a Florida Campus Compact member school in good standing.
- Applicant must participate in community service activities that:
 - a) benefit the campus and/or community
 - b) address social, political or economic issues
 - c) demonstrate leadership for social change and/or civic engagement
- Service efforts must provide service for the community at large. Religious, fraternal, or professional groups providing services **ONLY** to members will not be considered.
- Service efforts must have been performed in Florida or as part of a Florida campus sponsored service activity, during the **2010 calendar year.**

Requirements:

1. A completed and signed ***application form.***
2. ***Four completed application questions.***
3. A completed ***personal statement*** addressing the specific service(s) you provided and how your involvement with community service impacted you and those you have served. Please include any innovative approaches used to build, enhance and/or sustain campus-based efforts to address community issues/needs, and the use of diverse strategies of engagement (service, service-learning, policy work, advocacy, civic education, etc). *****Personal statement should be 2-4 pages, Times font, 12 point, and double-spaced. Photographs may also be included.***
4. ***Two completed recommendation forms,*** which include two letters of recommendation from a campus administrator, faculty member, or community representative who is familiar with your community involvement and its impact on social change, civic engagement, or other community benefits.
5. A completed ***community service/service-learning resume*** that lists and explains all of your collegiate service involvement in campus-based and/or off-campus service.
6. ***Official proof of enrollment*** for the Fall 2010 semester, such as a transcript, letter from Registrar, or Certificate of Attendance.

Expectations:

EIS finalists must provide a headshot photograph if selected, and consent to having their photos and quotes included in press releases and other promotional uses by Florida Campus Compact, including the FL|CC website.

If I am one of the recipients of the 2010 EIS Award, I will make every effort to attend the 2011 Student Scholars' Institute and accept my award.

I hereby authorize and consent to the forwarding and review of this information to the Excellence in Service Awards Selection Committee. I understand that the data collected will be reviewed by authorized members of the EIS Selection Committee in consideration of me for the EIS Award.
